

Bob Peterson of Sabina in Fayette County serves as President of the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation, a 225,000-plus member organization founded in 1919.

Peterson also serves as a member of the American Farm Bureau Federation Board of Directors representing the Midwest Region.

Peterson served as Fayette County Farm Bureau president from 1990-1992, received the AFBF Young Farmer & Rancher Award in 1992 and served as OFBF Treasurer until September 2001, when he was elected First Vice President. He has been a member of the OFBF board since 1995. He serves on the Ohio Farm Bureau Board of Trustees representing Farm Bureau members from Clinton, Fayette, Greene and Warren counties.

Peterson's farm is a joint operation with his father and brother producing grain and livestock. He has been active in Farm Bureau since 1984. In addition to Farm Bureau, Peterson is a Fayette County Commissioner and is involved in church, community and 4-H activities.

He graduated from the Ohio State University with a bachelor's degree in agriculture. He and his wife, Lisa, are the parents of three children.
