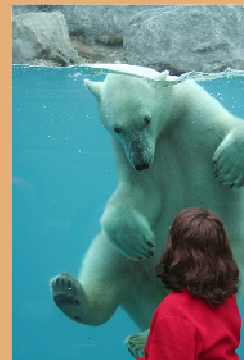


LOOK WHAT'S NEW AT THE ZOO!

Have an up-close and personal encounter with a polar bear at the zoo's new Polar Frontier, a "state-of-the-art interactive exhibit that will be home to two polar bears, two Alaskan brown bears and Arctic fox."



Watch polar bears in their ultimate habitat with lots of rocks, pools, smell ports, dig pits and shelters. Their 167,000 gallon pool has areas where guests can view the bears from above, at eye-level and from below.



Polar Frontier also includes an interpretive center with games and a playground area for children.
