1. Must be enrolled for the fall quarter/semester 2012 at a two or four year college or university in Ohio, as a full-time student.
2. Must be enrolled as a full-time student in an Agricultural related field (includes horticulture, forestry, ag-business, etc.)
3. Must be a resident of Erie County.
4. Parent(s) or student must be a member of Erie County Farm Bureau, Inc. and membership must be currently paid. (For membership information call 888-216-5487)
5. A transcript of your high school grades must be attached to the scholarship application form. We require a 2.0 minimum grade point for consideration.
6. A resume must be attached to this application.
7. Please attach a recent photo of yourself.
8. You may be contacted for a personal interview.
9. If awarded, payment for the scholarship will be made to the student if a 2.0 or higher average is obtained for the first quarter and the student is continuing with his/her education in an agricultural field. A copy of the spring or second semester paid invoice, along with a copy of the fall transcript must be sent to the Erie County Farm Bureau before payment is made.
10. Scholarship application must be received by March 15, 2012.
