



WHAT: Horse March to benefit the Cleveland Mounted Police Unit

and the Cleveland Police Mounted Unit*

WHEN: Saturday, September 22, 2012

9 a.m. - Assembly of riders and horses at the Cleveland municipal parking lot located off the Shoreway off East 9th Street

9:45 a.m. – Welcome address

10 a.m. – Step off of horse march thru downtown Cleveland

Horse march includes several stops along the route including the Horseshoe Casino on Public Square. Route is approximately 3 miles total.

WHERE: Downtown Cleveland, start and end at the Cleveland municipal parking lot off the Shoreway at East 9th Street.

WHO: All riders and horses are welcome to join us for a unique experience of riding your horse in downtown Cleveland with the Cleveland Police Mounted Unit leading the march. No horse? Not riding? Come out and spectate and support the Mounted Unit.

WHY: To heighten awareness to the Cleveland Police Mounted Unit and help raise funds to purchase additional equipment including 3 saddles and tack for additional horses to be added to the mounted unit stable. No fee is being charged to ride, however donations will be graciously accepted/ to be collected using cowboy boots and muck buckets.



WHAT ELSE: *Tail-gating* at the parking lot following the ride will include a food concession stand and a variety of items for sale by the police mounted unit.

PARKING LOT DETAILS—City of Cleveland Parking Lot (Muny Lot)

From I-71 north or I-77 north

Exit onto East Ninth Street.

Go north on East Ninth Street. (pass thru the following intersections: Carnegie, Prospect, Euclid, Superior, St Clair, Lakeside)

As you approach Lakeside Avenue move to the right lane. Continue through the Lakeside Ave intersection. You will see a sign that indicates a shoreway entrance /Route 2 east on the right just past a parking garage on the right.

The shoreway ramp is also the access road to the Muny parking lot.

Turn right onto shoreway ramp /Route 2 ramp and you will see a large sign “City of Cleveland Parking Lot” - bear to the right—the access road for parking is on the right.
