SCHOLARSHIP

Overview and Eligibility

Warren County Farm Bureau offers a minimum of five scholarships per year for those pursuing higher education with a preference for majors in agriculture or agriculture related fields. These scholarships may be valued from \$500.00 to \$ 1000.00. Additionally the Family of Fred D. Pursley, is offering an additional \$1000.00 scholarship, to honor his many years of service to the Warren County Farm Bureau.

The application process is twofold. The first phase requires the submission of a written application. Phase two requires an interview with the scholarship committee.

Additional requirements include:

1. Applicants or their parents must be members of Warren County Farm Bureau by March 1st of the year in which they apply.
2. Applicants must attend or be accepted to an accredited college, technical or trade school.
3. Applicant must be a full-time student pursuing an undergraduate degree.
4. Preference shall be given to students pursuing a degree in agriculture or an agriculture related field.
5. Scholarships will be awarded a maximum of three times.
