PURPOSE: To implement a scholarship for any student attending an institution of higher learning and majoring in an agriculture related field, so that he/she may be able to apply the scholarship toward tuition, books, etc.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: This is a renewable scholarship with the amount to be determined by the number of acceptable qualifying applications.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be a resident of Lake County and parents/guardian or themselves a Lake County Farm Bureau member for a minimum of one year. Applications must include 3 references, one of which must be a Farm Bureau member. Students must prove enrollment, or letter of admission to a two or four-year institution of higher learning. Students must be considered a full-time student, with a renewable award for pursuing undergraduate as well as graduate studies. Applicants must be majoring in an agriculture-related field and must have at least a 3.0 grade point average.

APPLICATION PROCESS: The applicant will supply a completed application and will provide an essay (not to exceed 500 words) in response to the question provided on the application.

APPLICATION DUE DATE: April 24th. (postmarked/received)

JUDGING: The decision of the Lake County Farm Bureau Board of Trustees will be final.

AWARD: The award will be payable after the first term of study upon receipt of grades and review by the Board of Trustees.
