- PURPOSE:** To implement a Youth Scholarship Award for any Trumbull County Farm Bureau student who is either planning to attend or is attending a College, University, or Technical school.
- SCHOLARSHIP:** Award amount to be determined each year by the Board of Trustees.
- DUE DATE:** **April 23, 2014.**
- JUDGING:** Scholarship selections will be made by three (3) Board appointed trustees and one outside educator, with final approval being made by the Trumbull County Farm Bureau Board of Trustees.
- AWARD:** The scholarship will be awarded as a certificate at the recipient's high school awards program and the Trumbull County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in August. The actual scholarship money will be available upon proof of completion of the first quarter or semester. Scholarship monies can be picked up at the Farm Bureau office in Orwell prior to March 31st of the following year. The Trumbull County Farm Bureau reserves the right to withhold scholarship monies if the above qualifications are not met.
- ELIGIBILITY:**
- (A) Applicant's immediate family must be current Farm Bureau members.
 - (B) Applicant or applicant's parent/guardian must be a Trumbull County Farm Bureau member.
 - (C) Applicant must prove enrollment in a 2 or 4 year degree program and can apply for undergraduate degree only.
 - (D) Applicant must be considered a full-time student by his/her College, University or Technical school.
 - (E) Applicants may re-apply yearly for the scholarship but are limited to two (2) Farm Bureau Scholarships.
 - (F) Applicant must present him/herself to the selection committee for a personal interview.
Interview dates are:
Saturday, May 3, 2014, 6:30 – 9:30 PM
Saturday, May 10, 2014, 6:30 - 9:30 PM.
The **ONLY** alternate date will be **Thursday, May 8, 2014,** 6:00 and 7:45 PM.
All interviews will be conducted at the Trumbull County Agriculture and Family Education Center, 520 W. Main Street, Cortland, Ohio.
 - (G) Please include a recent picture to be used for our scholar's page in our annual meeting booklet.

2. Attach a three to five-hundred (300-500) word essay; using a 12 point font or larger with one (1) inch margins; double spaced, answering the following questions.

“What can Farm Bureau do to become more volunteer friendly?”

3. Attach two (2) signed and dated, **current** letters of recommendation, with contact information and phone numbers, addressed to the Trumbull County Board of Trustees.

4. Attach a copy of your high school and/or college transcript of grades.
