The Knox County Farm Bureau will be awarding a \$1000.00 scholarship to a qualified high school senior from Knox County who will be pursuing further education. The academic grant will be awarded to the student based on the following qualifications:

1. The student must be planning to pursue a degree at any two or four-year accredited institution. Monies must be distributed within 18 months of award date.
2. The student must have an accumulative 2.5 GPA at the accredited institution. The grant will be awarded after delivery of the first quarter or semester transcript, and can be applied to any expenses as the student sees fit.
3. The enclosed application must be filled out as completely as possible for full evaluation and possible award.
4. The committee will judge based on evidence of deliberate research and thoughtful analysis as well as writing quality. We are not looking for any specific answer or opinion.
5. Parent(s) of the applicant must be a member of the Knox County Farm Bureau (membership must be current at time of application and distribution of monies).
