Butler County Farm Bureau Food and Animal Issues Action Team is sponsoring a contest for all county 4-H and FFA participants. The contest will support Ohio Agriculture and our desire as farmers to produce abundant and safe food supply.

The theme for the contest is "Ohio Agriculture Fills your Plate with Abundant and Safe Food Products" and any format can be used to decorate the pagecoloring, painting, drawing, picture collages, etc. *It is your choice.* Please fill your plate/glass with products grown or raised in Ohio. You will also need to provide one fact about Ohio Agriculture that relates to the agricultural products you have chosen to fill your plate or glass.

Contest entry forms will be available on April 1 and the deadline to return the entry is June 15 or earlier if you would like.

Contest forms will be e-mailed to each advisor as well as available on the Farm Bureau facebook page and webpage at butler/ofbf.org. Forms will also be available at the OSU Ext. Butler County webpage.

The contest entry can be returned to OSU Ext. Butler County (8:00 am - 4:30 pm) or dropped off at the BCFB office at 2273 Millville-Oxford Rd., Hamilton (limited hours).

Each age group will have 10 entries selected by the BCFB Trustees which will be displayed in the Farm Bureau fair booth. All other entries will be displayed throughout the fairgrounds during the fair.

Patrons to the booth will vote for their top two favorites for each age group during the week. Age groups: 5-8, 9-12 and 13-18
One vote per day and patrons must vote for 2 entries in each age group.

The entries voted as the top two favorites in each age group will each be awarded a \$50 cash prize.
