Community Partnership Pays off for Great Parks Bridle Trails

Great Parks of Hamilton County and the horse community are “riding high” now that a five-year horse trails renovation project is complete. Over 5 miles of *horse trails at Miami Whitewater Forest have been reconstructed thanks to community organizations partnering with Great Parks.*

The official ceremony to celebrate the renovation of horse trails A, B and C was held Monday, May 18, 2015, at the Miami Whitewater Forest wooded horse trail shelter area. Over 60 attendees representing 14 organizations, 7 businesses and individual donors joined the Great Parks staff and Great Parks Foundation to celebrate the special occasion. The ceremony included the unveiling of a new trailhead sign depicting a map of the newly renovated trail system complete with a list of project donors.

“These horse trails are invaluable resources for our community, economy and the wellness and enjoyment of trail users,” says Great Parks Executive Director Jack Sutton. “If it wasn’t for the pure heart and soul of these dedicated folks, the trails would not be making the impact that they are today.”

The Miami Whitewater Forest horse trails are ranked in the top 30% statewide as a favorite Ohio riding location (for miles ridden) by Ohio Horseman Council members.
