The Richland County Farm Bureau annually offers **two \$500 scholarships** to deserving students that meet at least one of the following criteria:

- High school senior whose parents/guardians are Richland County Farm Bureau members, and is entering agriculture related course of study at an accredited college or university as a full-time student.
- High school senior whose parents/guardians are Richland County Farm Bureau members, and is entering a general studies course of study at an accredited college or university as a full-time student.
- College student whose parents/guardians must be Richland County Farm Bureau members, and is presently enrolled in an accredited college or university as a full-time student in agriculture related course of study.

Please type or print application neatly. Applicants need to **attach a transcript** from the academic institution they are currently attending and at least **one letter of recommendation** from someone other than a relative (example: a teacher, pastor, advisor, employer, etc).

Applicants can feel free to attach additional pages if they need more than the space provided. An electronic version may also be emailed to an applicant by request to [richland@ofbf.org](mailto:richland@ofbf.org).

Applications are due to the Farm Bureau office no later than April 30. Recipients will be selected by May 31.

Scholarship winners that are seniors in high school will receive their award after completion of their first collegiate grading period. Scholarship winners that are enrolled in college will receive his/her scholarship after their next semester of classes. All recipients must have a 2.5 GPA (or equivalent on a 4.0 scale) during that grading period in college. Recipients will also need to produce proof that the student is enrolled as a full-time student for the next grading period.

Recipients will be given three tickets to attend the Richland County Farm Bureau annual meeting in September where the scholarship winner(s) will be recognized.
