ADULT PROGRAM

Overview

The adult leadership program is designed to develop a community of well-informed individuals through first-hand educational experiences. The program enrolls participants who have a commitment to the Geauga County community and who are interested in assuming greater responsibility for the future leadership of our county.

Participants dedicate one full day a month for ten months (September - June) to these educational activities.

Learning experiences are designed to increase awareness about the community, while cultivating and enhancing leadership, management and interpersonal skills that will enable participants to assume greater responsibilities within their respective organizations and the greater community. By exposing participants to various aspects of community life, Leadership Geauga calls on our future leaders to imagine real-world solutions to the challenges in our county. We work to inspire participants to produce visible and positive change.
