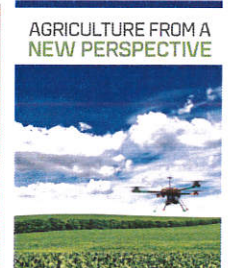


Highland SWCD Celebrates 75 Years in Conservation!

Load up and head to stop#2

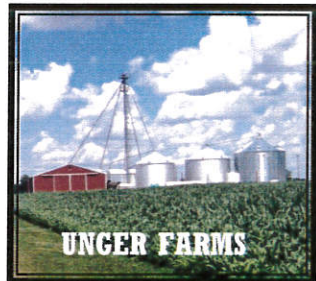


AGRICULTURE FROM A NEW PERSPECTIVE
