

## **Columbiana County Farm Bureau Scholarship**

### **PURPOSE:**

-- to provide scholarships for Columbiana County Farm Bureau member students attending an institution of higher learning. Scholarships are to be applied toward tuition, books, housing, etc.

**SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:**        \$750    qty (4)

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Applicant must be a Columbiana County Farm Bureau immediate family member.

Applicant must be considered a full-time student.

Applicant must maintain at least a B or 3.0 grade point average.

Applicant must be a high school senior or a full-time college student.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

Notices of the scholarship will be sent to all Columbiana County High Schools, placed in the County Farm Bureau newsletter, and all local newspapers. Scholarship forms may be obtained through the County Farm Bureau office.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Applicant must provide a completed application.

Applicant must prove enrollment, or submit a letter of admission, to a two or four year institution of higher learning or graduate school.

Applicant must include two (2) letters of reference (someone other than immediate family).

Applicant must include an official high school or college transcript.

Applicant must include ACT/SAT scores.

### **APPLICATION DUE DATE:**

**Must be postmarked by March 15<sup>th</sup>.**

***ANY APPLICATION NOT FULFILLING THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED BY THE JUDGES.***

### **JUDGING:**

A committee of Farm Bureau members will judge the applications by number only. No names will be made available to the judges. The decision of the judges will be final. The award will be made on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, handicap, or religious affiliation.
