





#### The Buckeye Agricultural Museum and Education Center,


Wayne County's up and coming tourism attraction, was developed by a small group known as Friends of Wayne County Fair.

The rapidly growing museum is housed in a 19,500-squarefoot building that was previously a farm implement and automobile dealership. It occupies a three-and-a-half-acre parcel directly across from Gate 3 of the Wayne County fairgrounds, making it a popular parking lot for fairgoers. This year fairgoers will be able to lease their own week-long fair parking space for \$50. Ask staff for application.

On the exterior, the museum features colorful murals painted by Orrville artist Kristin Lorson, as well as a silo that serves as

the entry. Inside, it presents a rapidly expanding collection of artifacts donated by Ohioans dating from first settlement in the state, until WWII. Among the items shown are a Massillon-built Russell steam engine, Orrville-built Champion threshing machine, Jerome M. Smucker's original apple butter kettle, collection of Ohio-built corn shellers, agricultural signage, Wayne County Fair museum room and an art gallery. Docents will be on hand to answer questions.

Food by Buehler's BBQ wagon and "Here's The Scoop" farm stand which will be providing Chocolate, Vanilla, Cookies and Cream, and Peanut Butter Crunch ice cream the old fashioned way with a 1923 John Deere hit miss motor.

Since our inception on April 15, 1996, The Hartzler Family Dairy has produced award winning Milk, Cheese, Ice Cream, Chocolate Milk, Egg Nog, and more. The Hartzler Family Dairy exists to encourage healthy living, to promote superior dairy practices, and to reflect the love of Jesus Christ in the products and services we provide.

Our milk is sourced from only local Dairies that are Non-GMO Project Verified and Hartzler Quality Certified, which requires the omission of pesticides and herbicides. The Hartzler Family Dairy uses a process called Low-Temperature Vat Pasteurization. This ensures that our milk retains a majority of its enzymes, which are crucial for proper digestion and good health. While most milk undergoes homogenization, ours does not. We choose not to homogenize because it changes the molecular structure of milk, which has unhealthy consequences. In particular, it prevents the delivery of important nutrients to the body. We are passionate about the goods that we produce and are truly grateful for all the love and support from our local Wayne County

During this year's Farm Tour, we will be teaturing walkthroughs of out processing plant followed by pulled park and beans at our on-site Ice Cream Shoppe.




We are honored to be hosting a stop on the 2018 Wayne County Farm Tour!

Join us on the Farm Tour for an exclusive lunch mem of pulled pork and baked beans, our famous homemade Hartzler Family Dairy ice cream as well as self-guided tours through our processing plant.







AppleBerry Belgians Farm is owned and operated by lynn and Shirley Nickles, along with help from daughter and son-in-law Janel and Brett Wilson and grandgirls, Haley and Hanna Wilson. We farm 28 acres of prime, small bale hay, using an accumulator and bale grabber. Also on the farm are apple and blackberry orchards. As the name indicates, AppleBerry Belgians Farm has two Belgian mares that are used as work horses as well as a 1 year old Belgian colt. lynn and Shirley also sell, raw local honey and brown eggs.

Games, activities, and petting animals will be on hand for the little ones. We will be conducting apple cider pressings throughout the weekend. Tri County Beekeepers Association will be on hand Saturday and Sunday giving demonstrations on beekeeping. From 1-4 on Saturday, Emanuel Miller from Moreland Fruit Farms, will be doing an orchard walk. Also, from 2-4 on Saturday come on out to hear your favorite polka's and waltz's. You may even get a chance to see Lynn play along. Sunday from 2-3 we will have a horse harnessing

We love everything about fall and would like to give people a chance to create great memories throughout the pumpkin season." Ohio Pumpkin has a variety of goods and activities to offer the public. From locally harvested raw honey and maple syrup, along with kettle corn, Bauman Orchards apple cider, pumpkins/gourds, Indian corn, to a 10-acre com maze, jump pad, hayride, jungle gym, tire mountain, petting zoo, pumpkin bowling, face painting

and potato sling shots just to highlight a few. Also present, is a Keating Catering food truck that has super steak, Italian sausage, fair style fries, lemonade shake-ups and more.

A portion of the proceeds goes towards the staff at Ohio Pumpkin where the local Northwestern FFA group, students and Wrestling dub help manage the activities. Ohio Pumpkin is located 3 miles south of West Salem at 10558 N. Elyria Rd just south of the SR 71 ramp. General admission is FREE, the hayride and corn maze are \$2 per person each. 




The Tegtmeier family has lived in Congress Township in Wayne County for over 80 years. Tegtmeier farms started in the early 1930s. Over the years the farm has grown and is operated by partners Jim Tegtmeier and his brother Don and lim's son Randy Tegtmeier. The farm consists of traditional crop production of corn, soybeans, wheat, and alfalfa, along with specialty crops of pumpkins, sunflowers and peas. The Tegimeier's also raise beef cattle and operate a Pioneer Seed business.

Sunny Side Feeds LLC is a family owned feed mill specializing in birdfeed and related ingredients. The business was bought by partners Wade Mahoney and Randy Tegtmeier after being approached by the previous owner in 2013. Since the change in ownership the business has grown to include additional services such as grain cleaning, and brokerage of specialty crops. With the addition of the cleaning tower in 2016 we have started to work closely with brewers and malt houses to produce high quality grains for brewing. As with many businesses one project leads to another. This business has presented the opportunity to work closely with Tegtmeier Farms and give us both the ability to grow and complement each other. Many of the ingredients produced are grown right here on the farm.

Activities at the farm for farm tour participants will include tours of the Sunny Side Feeds birdseed production, wagon rides to the pumpkin patch, and hands on activities for children. Pigtails BBQ Company will be onsite and offering food.
