## **OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM:**

### ***Why and who should attend***

With an ever growing population and concerns over food security, there is a need for a workforce of talented young scientists who are able to think critically about the issues associated with providing safe, economical, and aesthetically pleasing food and fiber. This one of a kind science camp will engage students in the various careers in science, engineering and technology in the food and fiber industry that will be needed to face our world's challenges. Through hands-on tours and activities in state-of-the-art laboratories, campers will get a unique look at what careers in science can entail. Days will be filled with learning from the top agricultural science companies and researchers at Ohio State and Central State Universities. Campers will get to network with leaders in the industry while gaining a new perspective on the variety of careers available to them in Ohio related to food and fuel production. At the end of each day, counselors will lead the students in leadership development activities and programs to show them how to prepare for college and their future careers.

This action packed week will be highlighted each day with a field trip to a different agricultural/food business (i.e. Smuckers, Mohican State Park, Select Sires) followed by an interactive, on-campus lab activity (i.e. food science, greenhouses, meat lab). Students will be challenged through various activities to discuss current scientific issues facing Ohio and the world. Daily activities will engage them as they critically think through such issues.
