

2019 Application for AGRICULTURE INDUSTRY SCHOLARSHIP EXPERIENCE

This opportunity is for anyone who has an interest in agriculture and would like to learn more about opportunities within the industry. This is an intensive one week scholarship experience spent shadowing leaders, making connections, and pursuing jobs in the industry. After the week is complete you would be the recipient of a scholarship.

Did you know that 1 in every 7 jobs are related to agriculture? There are so many agriculture specialties beyond farming. This opportunity will provide exposure to many of those agriculture careers by allowing you to spend a few hours in the day to day operations of these careers. You will also be able to connect with leaders in the industry which could be advantageous for your future career. A daily schedule will be provided for the one week time frame of the scholarship experience.

REQUIREMENTS & PROCEDURES:

1. The applicant or parents/guardian must be a current member of the Muskingum County Farm Bureau in good standing.
2. The applicant must be a senior at a Muskingum County High School, or if home schooled they must reside in Muskingum County, and be enrolled in to attend their first year college; or the applicant must have graduated from a Muskingum County High School and be currently enrolled in their first year of college.
3. The applicant must plan to be a full time student at a two or four year institution. Preference will be given to those enrolled in an agriculture related field.
4. Each application must include a current school transcript.
5. The scholarship amount will be \$1500.
6. The applicants will be scored on the following criteria:
 - A) Application
 - B) Essay Questions
 - C) Communication Skills during the interview
 - D) Appearance and Professionalism

TIMELINE:

1. The Scholarship deadline is April 5, 2019. Applications are to be submitted to: Muskingum County Farm Bureau, 1625A Sharon Ave., Zanesville, Ohio 43701 or emailed to muskingum@ofbf.org
2. Personal interviews of the applicants will take place during the week of April 22-26, 2019.
3. The winners of the scholarship experience and scholarship will be notified by May 1, 2019 and a meeting will be held in mid-May to go over the schedule and expectations.
4. Applicant must be available for the internship during the week of June 17th-21st, 2019 and need to have transportation to and from the experience sites.
A stipend will be provided for gas and food.
5. Applicant must do an exit presentation to the Farm Bureau Board and Committee on July 16, 2019, at which time the scholarship will be presented. We would also request that the applicant attend the Muskingum County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting (date TBA) if they are available.
