- 5 gallon buckets (new or thoroughly cleaned- no residue)

- Flat face square shovels, scoop shovels
- Alcohol swabs or bottled rubbing alcohol
- Work gloves (leather, rubber, or cotton)
- Pans, buckets, pails

• Fence repair tools and supplies

• *Suggested items:*

- Fencing pliers
- Linesmen pliers

- T-post clips
- Fencing staples

• Personal hygiene kits

• *Suggested items:*

- Chap Stick
- Deodorant
- Hand lotion
- Hand soap
- Shampoo/conditioner

- Pocket tissues
- Socks
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Wash cloth
- Wet wipes

• Livestock health kits

• *Suggested items:*

- Flashlight
- Iodine
- Gloves/OB sleeves
- Stretch gauze bandage rolls
- Rectal thermometer
- Livestock probiotics
- Pill gun

- Blu-Kote
- Scarlet Oil
- Red-Kote
- Electrolytes
- Tweezers
- 12 and 20 cc syringes
- 16x1 needles
