- 2. Raffle tickets will be sold for \$10 each. A maximum of 350 tickets will be sold. Proceeds will go in the Tuscarawas County Impact Fund to help fund events that help cultivate an interest in agriculture
- **3**. Each ticket will be entered separately in the drawing. Each ticket has a separate and equal chance of winning as prizes are being drawn. Chance of winning is one divided by the number of tickets sold. There is no limit to the number of raffle tickets a participant may purchase.
