3D Meats is owned by Logan and Elizabeth Rohr and is operated among the Rohr family including Logan's brother Luke and wife Rebecca. Between both of their families, there are 6 sons. Three of them help in the business outside of their school activities.

The Rohr family has been farming in Wayne County for 3 generations. Almost all of the beef sold comes straight from the Rohr farm and pork comes from 2 local farmers. The Rohr family's passion is the meat industry, and their goal is to cut out the big processing plants and sell local meat straight to customers and the community.

The retail farm market offers a variety of fresh and frozen meat, produce, lunch meat and cheese. If you want to stock your freezer you can purchase a quarter, half or whole beef, a half or whole hog, or one of their family bundles. 3D also offers custom harvest and processing of beef, pork, bison, sheep, and goats.

During the Farm Tour, "behind the scenes" tours will be offered for visitors to learn about meat processing. 3D will also be offering their very own pulled pork during the tour!

Skylar Brook Farm is owned and operated by Dave and Christy Forrer and Andrew Wenzel. This 35 acre farm produces evergreen landscape nursery trees, Christmas trees, alpacas, and alpaca fiber products. In addition, the farm offers a large pavilion for weddings, and other private and business events. One especially unique feature on the farm is their BinZebo!

During the Farm Tour, there will be a wagon providing rides through the tree fields. Attendees can also check out the full line of tree planting and harvesting equipment, and visit their 14 Huacaya Alpacas.

There will be wreath making demonstrations, and fall grapevine wreaths will be available in the farm store, along with all of the alpaca products. Skylar Brook Farm will also host Yoder's Kettle Corn and Fresh Squeezed Lemonade for purchase as well as homemade ice cream made by a 1942 John Deere engine.



In 1978, the Orrville Railroad Heritage Society was founded by Robert Bixler, Howard Wade, Roger Scott Family, and others. Currently, the Roger Scott Family and members of the Wade family are leading the organization today.

The museum and railyard focuses on educating visitors about why the railroad was brought to Orrville by Judge Smith Orr. Judge Orr brought the railroad to Orrville to meet the needs of area livestock, including his own, also so Orrville could more easily trade livestock. In fact, Orrville was a large “horse” trading town in its early days.

Visitors during the Farm Tour will have the opportunity to visit the Depot museum at the Depot St address, view an antique tractor and farm equipment display, and purchase pork sandwiches from Patrick Farms.





A separate railyard site will offer a petting zoo, train rides, and displays of vintage rail equipment (including a 1954 EJ&E Caboose, a converted flatcar that is now an open-air passenger car, and a fully restored Plymouth Locomotive). 

- #1 - 3D Meats - 3-D Meats will be offering their very own pulled pork

The Douglass family consisting of John, Lois, Sarah, Tyler, Karly, Karter, Landon and Kenley have been in the dairy industry for seven generations.

They milk cows at three locations in Wayne County with a staff of 70 dedicated employees. As well as countless others who perform custom work such as heifer raising,

silage harvesting and nutrient application. At Bristol Dairy, cows are milked three times per day in a double 50 parallel parlor. Calves are raised until four months of age.

Crops grown include corn, alfalfa and cover crops. During the tour, we will have dairy vendors, milkshakes or ice cream, a food trailer and a western shop trailer.

Rittman Orchards and Farm Market is located in the rolling hills near Doylestown. Rittman Orchards is one of the area's oldest fruit farms, functioning since 1922. In 2004, the Vodraska family purchased the property from the Klopfenstein family and set about completely replanting the orchards, constructing a new farm market building, and adding cold storage and the cidery. Chris and Amanda Vodraska head up the orchard operation.

Chris manages things outside, while Amanda manages the farm market. Their daughter Abbie (4) is starting to help with small chores around the farm, and enjoys being outside...and the bakery cookies. Newborn Oliver doesn't know what he's in for yet. Chris's father Dale still helps with a lot of the tractor work, and his mother Peg helps out with baking, bookkeeping, fruit sorting... wherever she is needed. Chris's brother Matt is in charge of Bent Ladder, including all of the cider and wine-making.

The orchard is now a showpiece of diversified fruit farming spread across 125 acres dedicated to over 70 varieties of apples, more than 20 varieties of peaches, nectarines and other stone fruit, and various kinds of berries, pumpkins and many other types of produce. If it can be grown in Ohio, it is most likely grown here! Berries, apples and pumpkins are offered for pick your own, and last year we started a cut-your-own sunflower patch which we've expanded upon this year. We have a market on site where we sell our produce and our own baked goods, as well as additional food items, kitchen gadgets, and a selection of gifts. A newer addition to the farm is our sister business, Bent Ladder Cider and Wine. Here we make hard ciders and wines out of the apples and grapes that we grow.

During the farm tour, the Orchard plans to have at least apple and pumpkin picking available as well as the farm market. True Roots BBQ will be on-site and Bent Ladder's tasting room will be open. Live music will be available at 6 PM on Saturday and 1 PM on Sunday. Come out and join us at Rittman Orchards and Farm Market. We would love to have you!

Stollers' Organic Dairy Ltd. is owned and operated by Scott and Charlene Stoller, their children, and Scott's brother, "Uncle Dave". Scott's great grandfather originally moved to the 250 acre home farm from Monroe County Ohio in 1903 and purchased the farm in 1913.

The farm has been in the Riggerbach family since then. In 1996 Scott and Charlene and their small children moved to the farm and farmed with uncle George Riggerbach Jr. More than a generation has passed and the farm and the work force has grown. Mom and Dad are now Grandma and Grandpa and the farm is also a playground for cousins.

Many of the old buildings remain with the house and barn dating back to the 1840s. In 2001, the land was certified organic before there even was a sustainable market. The cows have been certified organic since 2003. At that point we joined Organic Valley who markets our milk.

Due to factors such as escalating land prices, we boys felt that we would be better off farming together than starting our own individual farms. In 2014 Stollers' Organic Dairy Ltd. was born. A few months later we began building another freestall barn, manure pit, and parlor. Then in 2018 we added another freestall barn. Currently we are milking

Walnut Hill Grain is owned by Nelson and Twyla Horst and Kevin and Jewell Horst of Shelby and operated by Dave and Luanna Dotterer and their son and daughter-in-law Jon and Lydia Dotterer (children Eden, Oliver, Otto, Isaiah and Elle). Dave's father moved to Wayne County from Paulding County around 1950 and dairied a few miles south of this location. Dave bought the farm at a sheriff's sale. When they opened the doors of what is presently the feed warehouse it was stuffed floor to ceiling with old tires. The field behind the shop was also used, illegally, as a tire dump. While many farm children may remember the chore of picking the rocks in the field, the Dotterer family had the chore of picking up tire pieces in the field.



Walnut Hill Grain buys and receives grain (corn and soybeans) at the facility and sells Walnut Hill brand bagged feed and animal supplies, as well as other popular brands such as Hi-Standard dog food, Form A Feed products such as HydroLac and TMR Stabilizer, and Dutch Harvest Net Wrap. The business celebrated their first anniversary of selling bagged feed in June and has been buying and accepting grain since 2020. The family also does their own grain farming as well as custom combining.

Walnut Hill Grain has been under construction most of the summer and is anticipating more in the future to accommodate the growing business. This year's focus was on growing storage capacity, almost doubling storage capacity with the erection of the largest grain bin. In the years to come, the family hopes to add a pit and bigger store front! The family does not exactly know what stage the construction will be in during the tour, so please be careful and observe marked off areas. Also note that depending on weather, the business could be receiving grain during the tour. Traffic could possibly be heavy and consist of large equipment such as tractors, wagons, semis and trailers. Please use caution and observe parking signs/traffic directors.

A Tupperware consultant will be on site hosting a warehouse sale with 20-50% off regular prices. The Chick Fil A Truck plans to be here from 12-7 on Saturday.


