Scholarship Qualifications

- The scholarship is open to adult female students from Shelby and surrounding counties who are headed to college for the first time or are returning to complete an interrupted education.
- Applicants must enroll in an accredited vocational school, trading program, or a two-year or four-year college starting in the fall or winter of 2023.
- Applicants must present the completed application to the Shelby County Farm Bureau,
 110 Industrial Dr. Suite C, Wapakoneta, OH 45895 on or before Monday, July 31, 2023.
- Applicants will be invited to a 30-minute interview.
- Judging shall be on the following basis:
 - * Character
 - * Initiative/Goals
 - * Financial Need
 - * Community Engagement
- This \$1000 scholarship will be made payable to the student upon proof of enrollment.
