

throughout their woods to collect sap. This sap is run through a reverse osmosis system before boiling. The boiled sap is then transferred to a diesel-fueled evaporator before bottling. In addition to learning about maple syrup production, attendees during the Farm Tour can enjoy a walk through the woods as well as the 6 acre lake on the property. There will also be maple syrup for sale.

Handicap parking will be available closer to the sugar house but general parking will be at the edge of the property off the road. A wagon will be available to assist attendees in getting back to the sugar house if they choose not to walk.

THIS FARM was bought in early 2000 as bare land. Since then, a new set of Amish buildings have been erected. A small greenhouse business was started, and today it has grown to 2 30 X 96 greenhouses that sell a large variety of flowers and vegetable plants in the spring. In combination to this we started to sell mum flowers in the fall. This fall we have a mum field of more than 13,000 mums.

Visitors during the Farm Tour will have the opportunity

to drive around the mum field which overlooks the Killbuck Bottoms. We will be offering a pumpkin and mum sale in addition to corn stalks, straw bales, gourds, freezer jams, and lots more.
