A VISIT TO the Buckeye Agricultural Museum & Education Center in Wooster will be a treat for young and old alike. The 19,000-square-foot museum features thousands of exhibits spanning a time period from 1800 to the 1940s.

Featured items in its several galleries include one of Ohio's oldest barns dating to 1814, a steam engine built by the Russell company of Massillon, a miniature farm scene created by the Stoller family of Orrville, a huge cider press that came from a mill in Norton, the original equipment used by Jerome Smucker to start the J.M. Smucker Co. and many displays related to such aspects of agriculture as dairying, barn raising, butchering, ice harvesting, grain processing, cheesemaking and much more.

Kids will be able to try their hand at sawing logs with a two-man timber saw and shelling corn with an antique hand-cranked sheller. There will be plenty of food on hand as well with EATZ serving wings, hot dogs, sloppy joes, Texas toast and beverages, and Ken and Kelly Oyer offering homemade ice cream churned the old-fashioned way using an antique hit-and-miss engine for power.

"In 2018 when the museum was last a stop on the farm tour we were just getting started and there wasn't a whole lot of see. That has changed markedly," said museum curator Paul Locher, adding, "We have taken in exhibit material from all over Ohio. Now you can easily spend hours here and still not see the whole thing. The Friends of Wayne County Fair have worked hard to make this a fun and educational facility that Wayne County and the entire State of Ohio can be proud of."

Docents and museum directors will be on hand to answer questions throughout the tour.

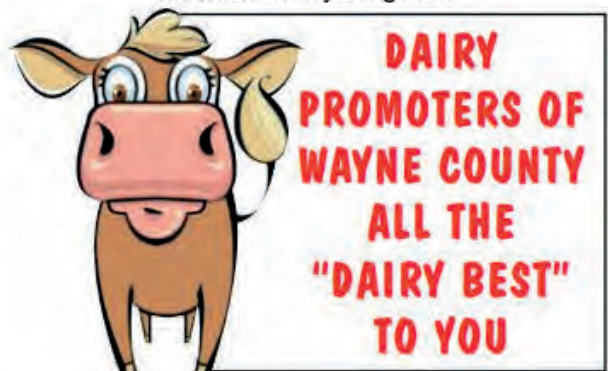
