

Ohio Farm Bureau's signature ag literacy and workforce development program, ExploreAg, offers **FREE** week, multi-day and day-long immersion programs for highschool students. In ExploreAg, teens learn about agriculture and related STEM fields from industry experts, scientists, and educators. Participants visit locations like Kroger and Bob Evans, manufacturers like John Deere and Certified Angus Beef, and research laboratories at OSU, Wilmington and Findlay. Youth are able to develop their leadership and collaboration skills and prepare for college and further careers.
