Each year we award multiple scholarships to students studying at accredited colleges and universities that all together total nearly \$15,000. While we encourage all students to apply, we do preference those students studying an agriculturally related field, or those who are involved in other agriculturally related activities.

This packet includes our scholarships qualifications, application, and letter of recommendation guidance. Please make sure to review the packet thoroughly and that all deadlines are met. All other records including our policy and procedures are maintained by the Franklin County Farm Bureau and can be reviewed, in-person, by request.

Scholarship Application Requirements

Applicant Qualifications

- Applicant (or the applicant's parent/guardian) must be a member of the Franklin County Farm Bureau when applying for the scholarship
- Applicant must plan to attend or be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student by their college or university of attendance
 - First-degree seeking, undergraduate students will be given priority consideration
- Applicants may receive one (1) scholarship each academic year as determined by their college or university
 - Previous recipients are required to reapply each year for consideration
 - Previous recipients are not guaranteed a scholarship in current or future review cycles
 - Each applicant is limited to four (4) scholarship awards over the course of their studies.
 - Applicants must meet the minimum cumulative GPA requirement of a 2.5.
 - High School Seniors are evaluated based on the cumulative GPA listed on their high school transcript
 - College/University students are evaluated based on the cumulative GPA listed on their college/university transcript
 - If no GPA is listed, the Scholarship Committee will calculate a GPA based on the grades listed on the transcript as of the date the scholarship application closes

Application Requirements

- Completed Scholarship Application
 - Prompts have a word limit of 250 words per prompt.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members
 - Additional information about format and submission options is listed in the *Letter of Recommendation Guidance* included in this packet
 - Previous applicants who maintain a cumulative 3.2 GPA through autumn term 2023 are not required to provide letters of recommendation
- Confirmation of Institution
 - College/University Students: Transcript that includes the most recently completed term of attendance
 - High School Seniors: Copy of their acceptance letter from college/university
 - If no acceptance letter has been received from the preferred institution, notify the Scholarship Committee via fcfbscholarships@ofbf.org

Confirmation of GPA

- College/University Students: Transcript that includes the most recently completed term of attendance
- High School Seniors: Copy of your current high school transcript
 - The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request a final high school transcript
