>>> LETTER FROM YOUR BOARD OF TRUSTEES

GETTING FRANK ABOUT THE FARM TOUR

As many of you know, the Wayne County Farm Tour is a long-standing event that has taken place for multiple decades to the delight of many repeat visitors. We frequently receive calls and emails each fall with a request for the booklet to be shared with them. Many of these folks mention that they are from out of the county and their family has been attending for generations. We are thankful for the loyal attendance and support that the event has been shown. This board and the trustees before us have always valued this event for the agricultural education it provides to the non-farming public, but the board has been having some serious conversations about the future of this event and we felt it best to be transparent with the membership.

It has grown increasingly difficult to find hosts, especially farms, willing to participate on the Farm Tour. The 2023 farm tour committee made an exhaustive list of every farm that they could think of within the quadrant, asked for suggestions from members, and still went through a list of over THIRTY FIVE farms and agribusinesses before finally reaching enough hosts that they felt could create a nice event for the community. It took months to narrow down the host list for the tour and, quite honestly, it wasn't until early July that we even knew if a tour was going to take place.

We do not fault the folks who declined to be on the tour. We know that life is busier than ever, with extreme demands on business owners to keep their farms going. At the same time, we can't continue holding a Farm Tour if we don't have hosts willing to participate. In light of the challenges that we saw in 2023 and a reluctance to take away such a popular event for Wayne County - we wanted to share our position with members and ask for help.


