YAP State Committee

The state committee members assist with the direction, creation, and execution of Ohio Farm Bureau's annual Winter Leadership Experience and other YAP programming. The committee consists of eight positions, each being filled by either an individual or a married couple. Members serve a 2.5-year term, with four returning committee appointments and four new committee position appointments each year. **Applications open each spring.**

Competitive Events

Ohio Farm Bureau's strength depends on its members' abilities to analyze agricultural issues and decide on solutions that best meet their needs. Competitive events allow the organization to recognize outstanding YAP members at the state and national level. OUTSTANDING YOUNG FARMER

A competitive award designed to help young farmers strengthen their business skills, develop marketing opportunities and receive recognition for their accomplishments. Contestants are judged on the growth of their farm businesses and involvement in Farm Bureau and their community. Applications open in August.

EXCELLENCE IN AGRICULTURE

A competitive award designed for young ag professionals who do not derive the majority of their income from production agriculture to earn recognition for their contributions to the agriculture industry, while actively contributing and growing through their involvement in Farm Bureau and agriculture. Applications open in August.

DISCUSSION MEET

A competitive event designed to simulate a committee meeting where participants build basic discussion skills, develop a keen understanding of agricultural issues, and explore how groups can pool knowledge to reach consensus and solve problems. Registration opens in August
