2026 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Brown County Farm Bureau is offering four \$500 scholarships to 2026 graduating high school seniors who are the children/dependents of Brown County Farm Bureau members. Additionally, a \$500 scholarship will also be awarded to a student currently enrolled in a two- or four-year college or technical school.

It is not necessary that the applicant have a farm background or plan to major in agriculture. As long as the parents/guardians of the student are members of the Brown County Farm Bureau, the student is eligible.

Evaluation of the applicants will be based on academic achievement, school and community activities, and short essays regarding the importance of agriculture to Brown County and the State of Ohio.

To obtain a scholarship, applicants must send a completed application, a copy of their high school transcript and a wallet size photo to the Brown County Farm Bureau, P.O. Box 288, Georgetown, OH 45121 or to brown@ofbf.org. All applications must be received by 4:00 p.m. on March 31, 2026.

If selected, the student must send the Brown County Farm Bureau proof of full-time enrollment (twelve quarter-credit hours or semester equivalent credit hours) and at least a 2.5 grade point average after either their first or second college grading period. All grades must be received by May 31, 2027. Checks will be made payable to the college/university. (Please send the mailing address of the college/university along with your transcript.)
