

Franklin County Farm Bureau Scholarship Application 2026

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS -

- Applicant (or the applicant's parent/guardian) must be a member of the Franklin County Farm Bureau when applying for the scholarship
- Applicant must plan to attend or be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student by their college or university of attendance. *First-degree seeking, undergraduate students will be given priority consideration*
- Applicants may receive one (1) scholarship each academic year as determined by their college or university. Previous recipients are required to reapply each year for consideration. Previous recipients are not guaranteed a scholarship in current or future review cycles. Each applicant is limited to four (4) scholarship awards over the course of their studies.
- Applicants must meet the minimum cumulative GPA requirement of a 2.5. High School Seniors are evaluated based on the cumulative GPA listed on their high school transcript. College/University students are evaluated based on the cumulative GPA listed on their college/university transcript. If no GPA is listed, the Scholarship Committee will calculate a GPA based on the grades listed on the transcript as of the date the scholarship application closes.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS -

- Completed Scholarship Application. Prompts have a word limit of 250 words per prompt.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members. Additional information about format and submission options is listed in the Letter of Recommendation Guidance included on our website. Previous applicants who maintain a cumulative 3.2 GPA through autumn term 2025 are not required to provide letters of recommendation.
- College/University Students: Transcript that includes the most recently completed term of attendance.
- High School Seniors: Copy of their acceptance letter from college/university. If no acceptance letter has been received from the preferred institution, notify the Scholarship Committee via franklin@ofbf.org.
- High School Seniors: Copy of your current high school transcript. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request a final high school transcript.

24. Prompt 2 - Describe your career goals and how your future career will fit in the Agriculture industry? (For non-agriculture majors describe how your future career may impact, affect or benefit the Agriculture industry?) (250 words) *

25. Prompt 3 - Based on Farm Bureau's mission, what contributions have you made in your community through your involvement in Farm Bureau or other community-based groups (4-H, FFA, etc.) Explain Farm Bureau's mission in your response. (250 words) *

In addition to submitting a current transcript, graduating High School Seniors are also required to submit the acceptance letter from their intended college/university.

Also required are two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members. Additional information about format and submission options is listed in the Letter of Recommendation Guidance included on our website. Previous applicants who maintain a cumulative 3.2 GPA through autumn term 2025 are not required to provide letters of recommendation.
