Overview

Our goal is to provide the expertise, tools and resources to implement an effective, on-going safety program, minimize risk and prevent injuries to workers.

Services

The following services are available at no cost to Group participants:

- **Phone/email consultation** - Members can contact the Safety Department any time with safety questions and requests for materials or services
- **Safety inspections**
 - Site inspection - An on-site, high level safety evaluation of the workplace
 - Reports - Email summary or basic report with findings, recommendations and photos
 - Follow-up - Guidance provided as requested by member to help implement corrective measures or correct non-compliant findings
- **Records Review**
 - OSHA or PERRP Logs
 - Training records
 - Incident investigations
 - Inspection records
- **Safety policies & procedures**
 - A high-level review of the member's existing policies and procedures with report of findings and recommendations
 - Provide available industry-specific policies and procedures, forms and checklists
 - **Desk Audit** - Off-site, high-level review of safety policies or procedures, training records, OSHA Logs, etc.
 - **Targeted review** - Detailed review of specific safety topics such as OSHA 300 Logs, safety manual, training records, policies/procedures, OSHA citations, etc.
 - **Safety training** - High level training materials or content available to the member and/or review of existing training materials. Web-based and on-site training available for a fee.
 - **Citation management** - An explanation of the OSHA citation process, review of citations and general recommendations.
 - **Claims/injury cause trend reports** - Used to help identify injury trends and where best to allocate safety resources.
